Welcome back to a new term.
Thank you all for your co-operation last term.

Just a few reminders of rules & safety.

1. Please be aware that while the gates are open from around 9.00am each morning – the yard is not supervised until 9.20 am when the bell rings.
2. Please take care when dropping and collecting children from school. Patience, courtesy & vigilance are called for at all times. Please do not park in or block the wheelchair parking space.
